Your attendance is highly important. The Presbytery requires a 50%+ quorum, or about 240 active members present in order to convene the meeting.

Approximately 295 people have RSVP'd that they will attend. If you didn't RSVP, please know you are still welcome to attend.

"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." 1 Thess. 5:16-18


