TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer's Update:

Through the end of October, giving totals \$760,466, which equals 65% of our \$1,175,000 operating budget for 2018. This compares with \$823,060 and 71% of budget through October 2017.

Over 55% of our budget goes towards the salaries and benefits of our excellent staff, and 20% goes to mission causes near and far. The balance covers program (ministry) costs, and administration and building expenses. We are a very active church, and your tithes and offerings are critically important in allowing many vital ministries to occur.

While we have dipped into our endowment to fund the current shortfall, the endowment is meant to be reserved for major building projects, new ministry initiatives or special situations like our transition to ECO. Special bequest gifts into the endowment have allowed us to complete major property projects in recent years including the new gym, sanctuary improvements, and parlor renovations without a capital campaign.

As you are able, please consider how you might excel at the grace of giving as we look to bridge the gap in funding our operating expenses as we get closer to the end of 2018.
