11:00 am - Hebrews: How Jesus was Deeply Jewish, and So is Christianity
John Chaffee is leading a Zoom class for people of all ages (youth and all the way up)
on the book of Hebrews. In the New Testament, Hebrews is an often overlooked
book that is rich with Old Testament references and imagery. As a follow-up to Mark
Wenger's course on Romans, Hebrews makes a lot of sense, because together, these
books present different angles on the same Jesus and Christian faith. At a time in the
first century when believers were experiencing a lot of push-back/harassment for their
faith, and some were tempted to leave it, and return to traditional Judaism, the writer
of Hebrews sought to show how Jesus represented the core of biblical Jewish
tradition, even as he transcended it. Our plan is to focus on one chapter each week,
discussing where Hebrews makes unique statements in the New Testament, and
chatting about how our ancient faith still is miles ahead of us today.

UPDATE FROM SAFETY AND SECURITY

The Way Remains Clear! After several months of planning, Narberth Presbyterian Church is resuming in-person, in-Sanctuary worship services this Sunday, October 18, with one service at 9:30 that will also be live streamed. Streamed services may also be accessed as a recording from the NPC website (www.narberthpres.org) for viewing later.

COVID Trends. Dr. Nina O'Connor and our team continue to monitor our local health conditions using data from the Pennsylvania Department of Health. While case counts have risen over the last 2 weeks, they are still far below levels seen in the spring, and local hospitals are doing well. *Please pray for continued stabilization of pandemic.* **Weekly Registration.** To date, 83 "Yes" RSVPs have been received to attend the Oct 18th in-person worship service. *Going forward, weekly registration for upcoming worship services will open on Sunday afternoons and close on Fridays. Be on the look-out for an e-mail invitation from NPC to register on-line or by calling the church at 610-664-4880 to manually register.*

What Will It Look Like? A video was created to show how worship will be familiar and different as we seek to minimize potential for Covid-19 infection while celebrating worship together again in our beautiful Sanctuary: Click Here for Video

What to Expect for Worship Services? Worship service will start with a single service at 9:30 and be limited to approximately 60 minutes and 90 congregants, with extra space created in the Chapel, as needed. Initially, there will be no separate programs for children or youth. Congregants will be required to check in and pass through a brief health screening and before entering the church. Social distancing and mask wearing are required at all times on church property. Our safety and security team, greeters, health screeners and ushers will ensure your health and safety by observing our safety protocols. *Doors open at 9:00; please plan on arriving early to allow for an orderly check-in process.*

How Can I Prepare? If you choose to return, please take a few minutes and review NPC's guidelines that are posted on NPC's website (click here) including two important documents: 1) Reopening Frequently Asked Questions; and 2) Guidelines and Protocols for Worship. Please pray for our leadership as we finalize our preparations for reopening. Please remember, there is no pressure for friends and members to resume in-person worship, as virtual options continue as vibrant and safe options for everyone at NPC.

Congregational Survey. Thank you for responding to our recent survey asking for your opinions on returning to in-person worship services. A total of 129 responses were received, with results and analysis shared with Session on Tuesday night. Your responses were extremely helpful for leadership to understand your views on the proposed health and safety measures and to inform our discussions and decisions on various worship planning modifications at this time.

Volunteers Needed. On Thursday night, with our hospitality ministry leaders, we hosted our final worship service training session. The session enabled participants to

learn more about the health and safety aspects of NPC's in-person worship services. In the session, Dr. Nina O'Connor provided a COVID update and stressed the importance of the "Four Pillars of Health" at NPC. Curt Haring provided an overview of safety protocols in "What to Expect in Worship Services". Eric Simpson highlighted the importance of our volunteers to ensure our Congregants health and safety as part of "NPC's Hospitality Ministries". The main topic, "Volunteer Duties, Locations, and Dynamics", was led by Eric Simpson, Dr. Nina O'Connor, Dee Knight, and Scott Todd. We concluded with "Next Steps" and how volunteers can sign up for worship services in October and November.

Please prayerfully consider joining our safety & security, health screener, greeter, usher, and live streaming ministries and contacting our leaders as noted below. You will make a huge difference that ensures the health, safety and security of our members and friends!

Safety & Security. We need volunteers with a passion for keeping our friends and members safe and secure. Our team oversees and monitors the health, safety, and security of our congregants by coordinating, communicating, and assisting our health screener, greeter, and usher teams. Also, in an emergency, we direct NPC's emergency response and contact with our emergency partners. Our leader is Eric Simpson, (simpsoe100@gmail.com)

Health Screener. Anyone with a passion for keeping our friends and members healthy would be a great help in serving in this ministry. Health screeners and greeters will check-in congregants and make sure they are registered and will ensure mask-wearing. They will also conduct health screening by asking COVID questions and administer a touchless thermometer before you enter the church. Greeter. As before, greeters remain the smiling, first faces that friends and members see as they approach and enter NPC. Greeters will also assist with ensuring good traffic flow and social distancing when congregants enter and exit our church. Usher. *Right now, our greatest need is for ushers.* Ushers actively seat everyone in the Sanctuary to ensure their social distance. Ushers also assist by monitoring and directing traffic flow to reduce congestion and encourage social distancing when congregants enter and exit our church.
