**Masking Optional to Return to Narberth Presbyterian Church, Starting Sunday, March 13 By a unanimous vote, the Session of Narberth Presbyterian Church approved a motion on Wednesday, February 23, to change from "Masking Recommended" to "Masking Optional", provided "the way be clear", meaning local health conditions continue to support this change. The motion was originally forwarded by NPC's Safety and Security Team. This happened because across all key metrics, Covid conditions are now rapidly improving. This recommendation was based on consultations with medical experts from within the congregation and after reviewing local health statistics for Covid mortality, hospital census/Covid admissions, positivity percentage and Covid case counts.

Here is the motion passed by Session on 2/23:

Starting on Sunday, March 13. Individuals who are "up-to-date" with their vaccinations (as defined by the CDC, those who have had all the primary Covid vaccines and any boosters they are eligible for) have the option to not wear masks indoors while encouraging and respecting the personal choice of those who wish to continue wearing a mask. This applies to Sunday worship, small groups, AA, Narberth Havurah and all Wednesday night activities, as well as to staff unless working in the Preschool or in Sunday school, nursery or activities with children under 5 years old, for whom no vaccine has yet been made available. Note, at this time the pre-school and children's ministry activities for those over 2 but under 5 years old will continue to be required to wear masks. It is not recommended now, nor has it ever been recommended, that children under 2 wear a mask. Together, we will continue to monitor developments to reassess the appropriate safety protocols on an ongoing basis.

This Sunday, either in person or online, we encourage you to hear more details about this change during the Family News. Dr. Nina O'Connor, a leading physician in our greater community, and medical advisor on our Safety and Security Team, will be sharing an important update.
