Missions Prayer Focus: CRU – Leah Darwin Leah Darwin is a veteran missionary of 45 years with Cru (formerly called Campus Crusade for Christ). She is a teacher of the Bible to a class that meets digitally composed of 365 people coming from Asia, Middle East and America. She works part time with the Digital Strategies Department of Cru in Orlando, Florida. For 35 years she taught at the Cru seminary in Manila, Philippines where students come from Buddhist, Muslim and Hindu countries to be trained as pastors and church leaders.
