PASTOR NOMINATING COMMITTEE UPDATE

The PNC has an update on both the Senior Pastor and Transitional Pastor searches.

For our Senior Pastor position, the PNC has hired a search firm, Shepherds Staff, to help find a greater number of qualified candidates. The PNC is still responsible for taking any forwarded candidates through our review process and for making final decisions. In order to help us, Shepherds Staff will be coming for a weekend visit sometime in early December. In addition, we continue to post our position on job sites. We are currently reviewing a recent submission.

In the search for a Transitional Pastor, after vetting and interviewing a potential candidate via Zoom, the PNC invited the candidate and his wife to come for a visit. They did so the weekend of October 14th. During their time here, the candidate met 1-on-1 with several key staff members and attended a staff luncheon. Both the candidate and his wife met with Session, the PNC, and attended Sunday services.

Upon the conclusion of their visit, the PNC received feedback from staff and Session. With that and our own time with him, the PNC unanimously and enthusiastically decided to extend a call to Farrar Griggs to be our Certified Transitional Pastor. He has graciously accepted our call and will be coming with his wife Cindy to NPC in just a few short weeks! In fact, his first official day is November 13th, the day after Steve retires. And just so you know, he also goes by the name of Skip.

Farrar was a naval officer before starting his own attorney practice for many years in North Carolina. During that time, he served in a variety of lay positions in the Presbyterian church, including thirty plus years as an elder. He also served as a lay pastor before going back to seminary to be ordained as an ECO pastor. He recently completed his DMin plus ECO Certification as a Transitional Pastor. In this capacity as an ECO Transitional Pastor, he has served at two different churches in recent years.

As a person and leader, Farrar is articulate, humble, intelligent, Spirit-filled, and wise. He understands what we are going through, has already given us helpful counsel, and is willingly moving from his hometown in North Carolina to serve us. And as he will wholeheartedly attest to, he is also coming with his greatest asset, his wonderful wife Cindy. She brings a lot of warmth and wisdom to us and is accomplished in her own right. By God's providence, they will be moving into an apartment across the street from the church.

We are so grateful to God for His provision and for all of you who have been praying for us. He is good! Thank you! Now, please pray for a smooth move for Farrar and Cindy and that they are able to settle in easily. Please also pray for the PNC and the person that God is calling to be our next Senior Pastor.

NPC FINANCIAL UPDATE

We are thankful for your financial participation with NPC. Your gifts allow our ministry to flourish, helping us to reach out and support missions locally and around the world, teach our children and youth, and maintain our church building.

Through September, your giving to NPC has totaled \$693,968, which is just ahead of last year at this time and represents 59% of our annual budget of \$1,178,400 for 2023.

Spending in budgeted areas is \$873,829.45, which is just below budget through three quarters.

It is a normal pattern to receive a large percentage of giving in the fourth quarter. Historically, this helps NPC to meet our budgeted giving number, but we do not take this for granted. \$484,432 is needed in Quarter 4 to reach budget.

We would ask that you prayerfully consider what you are able to give to help us meet budget, so we may fulfill God's purpose for NPC of building disciples in the love of Jesus Christ as we grow up in worship, grow together in community, and grow out in witness and service.

By donating stock that has appreciated for more than a year, you are able to claim the full market value of the stock at the time of donation as a charitable deduction on your taxes, and avoid capital gains on the stock. 
