Weather Policy

Always check Brightwheel for updates regarding weather

- If LMSD has a 2 hour delay:
 - NPCNS morning classes will be canceled.
 - Children in afternoon classes will have school as scheduled.
 - Kindergarten enrichment will still occur.
- If LMSD closes for the day due to weather, NPCNS will also close.
- In the event that LMSD is closed for a number of days due to power outages at their schools and if NPCNS has power and weather is no longer an issue, NPCNS will have school at the discretion of the Director.
- In addition, NPCNS will add two "cushion days" to the school year. What that means is in the event that NPCNS closes for 4 or more snow days over the course of the school year, 2 additional instructional days will be added at the end of the school year.
