- † Collecting now for donations to make toiletry bags for the homeless. We are collecting small or travel size shampoo and/or conditioner, shaving cream, disposable razors, soap, combs, washcloths, deodorant, toothbrushes, toothpaste, mouthwash (small size), as well as gallon size ziplock bags to put the item in. We deliver the bags to Neighborhood Crusades to distribute in their ministry to the homeless and needy in Philadelphia. Donations may be dropped off just outside the sanctuary entrance doors (by the drums) underneath the bulletin board.
- **Treasurer's Report:** Offerings through October total \$822,028, which falls \$45,573 short of YTD October 2015. \$394,972 (32% of budget) would be needed in Nov/Dec to reach our \$1,217,000 annual budget, though spending in budgeted areas is expected to be slightly below budget at end of year. For the year, operating expenses are \$465, 929 which is below last year's pace and \$11,830 below budget, and total employee costs are \$522,941, which is \$16,055 below budget. That leaves us with shortfall of \$166,841, which has been funded by cash on hand and our endowment.

Your gifts are an act of worship which God uses to further ministry near and far. We ask for your continued support of NPC's ministries to help bring us closer to our budgeted needs over the coming months, so we may finish the year well and enter 2017 on a strong footing. May the Lord bless you in your giving!
