## TREASURER'S REPORT

### Important Giving Update:

Through the first three weeks of December, your offerings totaled approximately \$975,000, slightly lower than last year's offerings through the same period. While \$189,000 short of annual budget of \$1,161,000 (about 16%), we do expect actual spending in budgeted areas to fall somewhat below the budget. It is also customary to receive a large percentage of annual giving during the month of December. Accordingly, as we approach the close of the year, we would ask that you prayerfully consider what you may be led to give in order to allow ministries to be fully funded this year. Your giving allows our ministry to happen, both near and far, and expresses our gratitude to God for his many wonderful gifts to us, especially in this season of Christmas as we mark his greatest gift of all - His Son.
