Offerings for the five September Sundays, plus online giving totaled \$81,472, bringing our YTD September total to \$709,652. That equals 62% of our 2019 budget of \$1,140,000. \$430,348 would be needed in the fourth quarter to meet our budgeted expenses, though actual spending has been below budget to date. A full YTD September report will be issued once all numbers are complete.
