ANNOUNCEMENTS

We at NPC are seeking to be prudent, prayerful, and non-panicky as we respond to the Coronavirus Disease. This week we have installed 8 new hand sanitizer stations throughout the church, including 2 in the sanctuary. We appreciate the preventive actions recommended by the Center For Disease Control (CDC) to help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Wash your hands often and vigorously with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.

We are praying for God's mercy and grace to stop the spread of this virus. We are praying for clear and accurate information so that we may respond well as a church and community. We are also praying for the faith to be able to identify a special purpose God may have in mind in these difficult days.
