11:00 am - Hebrews: How Jesus was Deeply Jewish, and So is Christianity

John Chaffee is leading a Zoom class for people of all ages (youth and all the way up) on the book of Hebrews. In the New Testament, Hebrews is an often overlooked book that is rich with Old Testament references and imagery. As a follow-up to Mark Wenger's course on Romans, Hebrews makes a lot of sense, because together, these books present different angles on the same Jesus and Christian faith. At a time in the first century when believers were experiencing a lot of push-back/harassment for their faith, and some were tempted to leave it, and return to traditional Judaism, the writer of Hebrews sought to show how Jesus represented the core of biblical Jewish tradition, even as he transcended it. Our plan is to focus on one chapter each week, discussing where Hebrews makes unique statements in the New Testament, and chatting about how our ancient faith still is miles ahead of us today.

It is an indepth study of racial justice and reconciliation. Each day, you will be drawn into a time of prayer, Scripture reading, reflection, and response led by various Black and white pastors and leaders. Welcome Back! We give our heartfelt thanks to our members, friends, and volunteers who joined us the past three Sundays for in-person worship and live-streaming at 9:30. Together, it has been a safe and uplifting worship experience. Thank you!

Local Health Conditions. Dr. Nina O'Connor and our team continue to monitor our local conditions and COVID Trends using data from the Pennsylvania Department of Health. Case counts and hospitalizations continue to rise in our region. COVID-related mortality is much lower than it was in the spring, and local hospitals have sufficient capacity, but the trends are still concerning. Please remain consistent with mask wearing, social distancing, and hand hygiene. The Safety and Security Team keeps in close contact with NPC leadership about these trends. *Please pray for continued stabilization of this pandemic and for health and safety in our community.*

Nov 8th Registration. To date, 40 "Yes" RSVPs have been received, leaving plenty of room for more members and friends to join us this Sunday.

Beginning this week, we ask if you are registering for your family to also indicate other members joining you similar to the pew notepads in the past. Here is how it works when you register on-line. First, using the "special notes" box, please list the first names of family members coming with you. Second, in the "number field", indicate the total in your family coming, including yourself. If you are coming alone, these items do not pertain to you.

Weekly registration is required for every worship service. It opens on Sundays and closes on Fridays. Look for an NPC e-mail this Sunday to register on-line or by calling the church at 610-664-4880 to manually register. Here are a few reminders for those attending the worship services:

- **Volunteers** please check in by 8:45 and be in position when doors open at 9:00.
- **Congregants** please check in and be seated by 9:15 to enjoy the Prelude music and to avoid lines outside. After the service is over, we encourage fellowship outside subject to masking, social distancing and limiting gathering sizes.

How Can I Prepare? Staff, volunteers, and congregants are required to check in and pass through a brief health screening before entering the church. Social distancing and mask wearing are required at all times on church property. If you have not attended yet but want to join us, please review important information posted on our website (click here) including: 1) A Welcome Video; 2) Reopening Frequently Asked Questions; and 3) Guidelines and Protocols for Worship. Please pray for a continuation of safe in-person worship services at NPC through the Fall and Winter.
