Yet within those limitations, Paul persevered with joy through his faith in Jesus Christ. Perseverance without joy equals drudgery and exhaustion; joy without perseverance is shallow and fleeting. Like Paul, how can we combine both? Spoiler alert: Paul said, "For me to LIVE is Christ." With whatever limitations we may be facing, together let's deepen our relationship with Christ through this amazing little letter. This class meets in-person (masks).
