Projects that Benefit NPC and the Preschool: Update Many shared Preschool/NPC projects that were funded through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant are now complete. The next projects underway include secure doors for the balcony and basement entrances to the Preschool (these will be open on Sunday mornings) and Courtyard beautification:

- A modest, permanent piece of small-child appropriate playground equipment is being installed, surrounded by soft mulch, new, growing grass, updated perimeter fencing and just outside, a new bike rack.
- We ask your patience while the Courtyard is closed to allow the grass/sod to take root and begin to grow for about a month.

We pray for all the contractors who have worked to make our property more beautiful, safer and more enjoyable. We also appreciate Preschool leadership, the Preschool Board, teachers, families and Preschool students for inspiring these improvements and finding a zero-impact way to fund them that benefits everyone.

Financial Update

We are very thankful for your financial participation with NPC. Your gifts allow our ministry to flourish, helping us to reach out and support missions locally and around the world, teach our children and youth, and maintain our church building. Through June, your giving totals \$439,047 which equals 40% of our 2022 budget of \$1,099,000, and is \$39,276 above giving at the 2021-mid year point. Total expenses in budgeted areas equals \$568,530, which exceeds year to date offerings by \$129,483.

A higher percentage of giving is normally received during the fourth quarter, so it is not unusual to have expenses exceeding giving at this point of the year. However, we anticipate our spending going above budget this year due to the necessary property projects. We have made a down payment for new boilers to replace our struggling, aging units, with a total installation cost of approx. \$88,000. Along with the front step repairs and various smaller projects, we will exceed our budget in the area of property this year, after being below budget in recent years. Thanks to your strong giving to conclude 2021 and to date in 2022, we do have cash on hand to cover these additional outlays, however we typically see a drop off during the summer months. We appreciate your remembering NPC with your giving while you enjoy your summer.

They do this by connecting the churches with partners from across the world and make different resources available, so as to help them become more outward looking and fruitful. In their largest ministry project, *Ambassadors Together*, Hank, Mona and the 4-D team have partnered with about 73 churches, reaching out to more than 5,700 kids, at least 50% of them being unchurched.
