Financial Update

Through August, your giving totals \$606,749 which equals 55% of our 2022 budget of \$1,099,000, and is \$15,972 above giving at the same time in 2021.

Total expenses in budgeted areas equal \$741,840, which exceeds year to date offerings by \$135,091. A higher percentage of giving is normally received during the fourth quarter, so it is not unusual to have expenses exceeding giving at this point of the year. To date, we have been able to cover this difference with cash on hand from our strong finish to 2021.

However, we anticipate our spending going above budget this year due to the necessary property projects. We have made a down payment for new boilers to replace our struggling, aging units, with a total installation cost of approx. \$88,000. Along with the front step repairs and various smaller projects, we will significantly exceed our budget in the area of property this year, after being below budget in recent years. As we start the fourth quarter, we ask for your help in finishing the year well and covering our expenses.

Each day will have its stand-alone theme and will take place in a local and accessible site, so come to one or all, as your schedules allow.
