The ministry to our brothers and sisters in Kensington continues to bless so many who are often forgotten or looked upon with disdain. Outreach workers at Project Home deliver the items our church donates and they are grateful for our support. As winter approaches, there is a need for warm coats (not wool), blankets, sweatpants and shirts, hoodies, long underwear, hats, gloves, and socks. Gently used sneakers and boots are also needed. Jennifer Bonovitz delivers food items in person. Juices and fruit packs, and soft breakfast bars are big hits. As parts of the Kensington area gentrify, efforts are being made for these dear folks to be forced out of the area without sufficient alternatives being offered to them. NPC GIVING UPDATE

We are finalizing numbers through the end of October, but at the end of October giving totals just over \$750,000 of our \$1.1 million dollar budget, which is very similar to where we were at this point in 2021.

That means, we need to receive \$350,000, or 32% of the annual total, in November and December to reach our budgeted need.

As mentioned previously, we expect to finish with actual expenses well over budget due to the property projects including the boiler and front steps. Jim Hoffman, Church Treasurer
