PNC Update The PNC has posted the Job Description and Church Profile on numerous job sites. As a result, we have steadily received submissions. Special Disaster Relief Offering for Turkey – Update. Through your generous support, we were able to raise \$10,155 to give to First Hope Association (FHA) to help with the Turkish earthquake relief efforts. FHA is a Turkish NGO established by members of the Association of Turkish Protestant Churches.

There will be a grief support group on the fourth Monday of the month, continuing through August. This grief group will be an informal gathering to share whatever is on your heart (i.e., open discussion).
