**Missions Update:** Victoria Moshkovskiy from our Mission Cause, Save a Life Intl., made a special request last Sunday. Save a Life is currently raising \$75,000 to purchase three vans/buses that will serve as a vital lifeline for women and children living in remote villages in Ukraine where there is no access to transportation. Would NPC consider contributing financially to help us meet this \$75,000 goal—or even adopting one of the buses at a cost of \$25,000? Thank you.

**Financial Update:** Through May 2025, two patterns are clear in Narberth Presbyterian Church finances: First, church leaders and staff are doing a faithful job overall in maintaining expenses at the levels approved by Session for the 2025 budget. Expenditures are running at about 100% of the budget. Giving is running at about 70% of the 2025 plan. While this is about 4 points better than last year at this time, this still represents a shortfall of \$159,307, year-to-date. It is the sincere hope of the Finance and Stewardship Committee that by bringing the needs of the church forward, you, the church's members and friends, will see fit to help bring giving closer to the level needed to sustain the church.
