Notes from Justice and Mercy: Our newest Justice and Mercy Advocate is Clara Louie working in the area of safe and compassionate refugee resettlement. In April, Clara led a Prayer Vigil at NPC for refugees which was both educational and inspirational. Participants were encouraged to pray, learn and share their resources in helping those most vulnerable. Two concrete ways to be involved are to attend a weekly inter-faith prayer vigil outside Merion Friends Meeting (615 Montgomery Ave.) from 10:00 – 11:00am on Saturdays to peacefully call for humane treatment of immigrants in our country. Two NPC folks have already been attending. Another way is to help an Afghan family of 6, who have moved temporarily to Havertown. They can use support and referrals in finding jobs and rental housing. The husband served as an interpreter with the USA coalition in Afghanistan. They have three school-aged girls and a 6-month-old baby. Anyone in the congregation who would like to come around this family as a welcome and support circle, and for leads in jobs and housing would be appreciated. Missions: Wycliffe Bible Translators (Al Shannon) Al and Barb Shannon served with Wycliffe in Peru, and were instrumental in bringing audio Bibles to the people there. 63 years ago, they were involved in starting a bilingual school and an agricultural project. Over 10 years ago, at the opening of a Quechua Bible Institute, Al was overjoyed to find that one of the institute's leaders had been the first believer in that area. Many years before, they had worked together in his village, where most of the people now are Christians!
