Missions: Rancho del Rey Hank & Anne Moller sold their PA home in 1954 and moved to Mexico with their 3 children. There they saw poor and homeless children living in the city trash dump. The Mollers took in "boys of the street" and in 1956 purchased a home south of Monterrey, Mexico. Soon, more than 50 boys joined their family. Their son, Daniel, continues the work of Rancho del Rey – a place where children who have been traumatized grow in safety, in an environment able to meet their physical, spiritual, social, emotional and intellectual needs, and where the boys' parents receive training, safe haven, and support to become healthy families. Pray for the boys, their parents, & the staff to accomplish the Lord's will for all of them.
