An Update from Session to Our Church Family

The Session met on Tuesday evening, October 14, with Rev. Scott Vance and Rev. John Groth from the Heritage Presbytery Ministry Partnership Team (MPT). Together, we discussed next steps for healing and moving forward as a congregation. We are grateful for their guidance and continued prayers as we walk through this process of restoration and renewal.

At this meeting, the Session approved two important steps:

To engage **Rev. Dorington ("Dori") Little and Rev. William ("Bill") Enns** to lead an ECO Governance Seminar and provide ongoing leadership coaching for our Session. Their ministry focuses on healthy church leadership and conflict transformation, and they will begin working with us soon.

To invite **Christina Severinghaus**, a peacemaking trainer, to lead a weekend of training for our Session, staff, and congregation. This will provide tools for understanding, forgiveness, and unity in Christ.

We are hopeful that these steps will strengthen our leadership, encourage healthy communication, and help our church body grow together in grace and peace.

Please continue to pray for wisdom, humility, and the healing work of the Holy Spirit within our Session and congregation. Weekly updates will continue to be shared in the bulletin and by email to keep everyone informed. Above all, we trust that Christ is present with us — leading us forward with His peace, unity, and love.

The three combined as HumanGood, to provide affordable housing that meets the needs of low-income older adults at a time when demand far outstrips supply, and the services provided are limited in their ability to keep residents in their homes as health care needs change. Our regular giving helps to support the work of providing a place to call home for older adults who might otherwise have none, and to offer a welcome in Jesus' name. Please pray for more places of affordable housing – here in the greater Philadelphia region, and beyond, through HumandGood.

In addition to affordable housing for senior adults, HumanGood, provides Life plan communities (also known as continuing care retirement communities or CCRCs), which provide housing and health care on a continuum that changes as the needs of older adults change. Many of our NPC seniors have lived in the Rosemont Village community, and Rydal Park.
