An Update from Session to Our Church Family

Dear Church Family,

The Session continues to move forward in this season of transition with gratitude and hope. We have begun working with Rev. Dorington ("Dori") Little and Rev. Bill Enns as part of the process to identify a transitional pastor for Narberth Presbyterian Church. This will take time and prayerful discernment, but we are confident that God is guiding each step, and we will move efficiently.

In the meantime, we are blessed to have Pastor Debbie leading and preaching alongside several guest preachers through the end of the year, including Rev. Dori Little, Dr. Diane Chen, Rev. Ken Green, and Pastor Steve. We are grateful for their partnership and faithful service during this time. As mentioned in last week's update, Pastor Little and Pastor Enns will work with our Session, Deacons, and staff November 21 – 23, and plan to worship with us on Sunday, November 23. Additionally, Christina Severinghaus will lead a weekend of Peacemaking Training for the Session, Deacons, staff, and congregation on December 6 – 7. This ECO course will include both teaching sessions and group discussions.

We continue to work closely with Pastor Debbie and the church staff in overseeing the daily ministry and life of the congregation. Please continue to keep us in your prayers — that we would continue this work with energy, joy, peace, and unity in Christ.

Missions: One of our mission causes, Cephas Tushima (founder of HESED Academy in Nigeria) is requesting funds for this school year. While the school year is now in full swing, the Academy needs closets and bunk beds for new boarding students, as well as desks and chairs for staff. The total amount needed is just over \$3,500. A recent update on HESED Academy: This summer the secondary section of HESED Academy graduated 10 students, and the primary section graduated 16. This year students' scores were very high on standardized exams, with West African exams completed in June and National exams in July. Currently, 70 students are enrolled in the primary section, 85 are enrolled in the secondary section, and 25 teachers are on staff.

Please keep Nigeria in your prayers, as it is one of the countries where Christians face severe persecution. Pray for God's protection of His people and the raising up of the next generation through ministries like HESED Academy.
