FINANCIAL UPDATE

The past several months at Narberth Presbyterian Church have included disruptions. Finance Committee planned to communicate earlier and more frequently in 2025 than in previous years regarding church finances but, humbly, we must acknowledge that this too was disrupted. So, if you feel you should have gotten more frequent and earlier information, you are correct, with our apologies.

All that said, for the first 10 months of 2025, donations totaled \$696,828, a monthly average of \$69,683 and a cumulative deficit of (\$282,574) less than the \$979,402 that was spent. In these figures there is some good news. Last year at this time we were approximately \$80,000 further behind (\$362,000) and with strong giving through the end of 2024, ended the giving year nearly at a break-even point. This congregation has historically weighted their gifts to as much as 50% of the annual amount given in the 4th quarter, but this year, we are coming into the 4th quarter considerably ahead of those numbers. Still, if giving does not accelerate, we will end the year with a deficit of about (\$250,000). You are not seeing an error. Aggressive expense management and prudent cost cuts will reduce the projected end-of-year deficit from the current level even if giving remains at the average amount of this year without an end-of-year surge.

As a supporter of Narberth Presbyterian Church, you may feel uncertainty causing you to withhold your gifts in response. While that is a logical human response that can be understood, faith is not always logical. We are called to believe before we see. Believing in this way can make the improbable, even the impossible, reality. God has made this happen before, He can do this right here, right now too.

So, as you look at your giving in the remaining 30-some days in 2025, please be in prayerful consideration. This message is in no way meant to burden those doing all they can, but possibly to inspire those who may be looking for a way to create positive impact with the great gifts God has given them.

It may also be a time to review your investments to see if you could create impact and experience practical tax benefits by making a stock gift to the church before the end of the year. Jim Hoffman, NPC's Treasurer, can confidentially consult with you on this process to show you how this works.

The members of Finance Committee along with all of Session appreciate your ongoing generosity and prayers. Please also be in prayer for the Session as they wrestle with planning the 2026 budget in a world that has changed a great deal since they planned the 2025 budget.
