The Finance & Stewardship Committee again expresses its thanks for your generous giving at the end of 2025 which allowed us to come within \$10,000 of our spending in budgeted areas for the year. We are aiming to increase and improve our communication to the congregation this year. Due in part to the impact of weather, giving for 2026 has gotten off to a slower start than normal, with a total January giving in the range of \$35,000. Our updated annual budget of \$1.14 million translates to about \$95,000 of budgeted spending each month. Accordingly, we wanted to remind you of alternative ways to give when you may be unable to physically make it to NPC:

- **Online Giving:** www.narberthpres.org/give is our secure online giving platform and is available 24x7 to accept both one-time and recurring gifts.
- **Text Giving:** Send a text from your cell phone to 833-279-6202 with the amount you wish to give; watch for prompts on how to confirm and designate your gift.
- **Check in the Mail:** Let the US Post Office deliver your gift for you.

Missions: Leah Darwin (CRU) works with women who have suffered betrayal in their marriages and/or abandonment, giving them hope and help in a safe space. She trains people on how to write their life stories, inviting them to co-write the rest of their story with the Holy Spirit. She continues to train and encourage leaders in Community Bible Study in the Philippines. Leah now lives in this area, and is traveling to different churches to speak, meeting with women one-on-one for counsel and prayer, exercising her artistic muscles, and enjoying time with her children and their families. Please pray for Leah to continue to flourish in ministry in this country.

Notes from Justice and Mercy: Over 27 million people worldwide are trapped in human trafficking – a crime that thrives by weaponizing vulnerability and stripping away agency with coercion and control. Many of us have encountered a person who is being trafficked without even realizing it, often in the service industries. How can we as human beings and a church respond? Our voices can stop it. You can help move the needle on critical bills, such as [The Sunset Section 230 Act](#) and [The Fix App Ratings Bill](#). As AI evolves, it is being used to automate coercion and create synthetic exploitation material. Awareness is your first line of defense. Each of us can pray for Sally Kapner as she serves as a catalyst for healing and restoration.

Grayling Ave Steps to Sanctuary In 2023, at a cost of approximately \$30,000, Narberth Presbyterian Church had the front steps to the Sanctuary on Grayling Ave professionally restored, and the Stone Masons did a beautiful job. Some of you will remember that the old steps were crumbling and no longer safe to use. The restoration work came with a guarantee, so long as we do not scrape or treat the steps with ice-melting chemicals. This is the reason, following recent heavy snowfall that they have been temporarily closed and cordoned off with caution tape. We will resume use of the front steps when snow and ice have melted. The front of the church is accessible from the parking lot steps which will be open at times of worship and accessible with a key FOB at all other times. Please join in respecting this restoration investment and staying safe in this colder and snowier winter than any in recent memory.
