Finance Update: Giving for September has gotten off to a slow start. To cover our expected expenses for the year, about \$550,000 will be needed over the final 3.5 months. Spending in budgeted areas remains below budget by \$87,000 but exceeds YTD giving by \$178,258. This is not completely uncharted territory; the last two years over 40% of giving was received in the final four months. We invite you to join in our vision and ministry with your generous giving over the remainder of 2026.

Wednesday Night programming begins on September 16! Join us for a church family supper starting at 5:45pm followed by programming at 7:00pm:

Kids Praise with Danielle Kauffman: Give your kids a mid-week spiritual lift filled with laughter, music and community! Each week we sing truths about God to help build a strong foundation of faith for life. We also explore rhythms with real instruments and together live out Psalm 98. Most importantly each child's unique voice is celebrated and loved. This program is best for PreK-5th grade, meets in the Choir Room, and a light snack is provided.

Life Together: Becoming a Place of Belonging with Pastor Jason Hsu: Come explore with us the biblical practices for becoming a place of belonging.
