Giving update:

Through the end of August, your giving totals \$590,777, which is just under 54% of our annual budget, and \$34,114 behind last year at the same point. Our total expenses in budgeted areas continue to be below budget in almost every area, totaling \$678,980. That leaves us with a year to date shortfall of \$88,203. It is our normal pattern to see strong fourth quarters to close that gap, and we would appreciate your participation in helping us to do that again this year.

One way to give is by the transfer of appreciated stock to NPC. Donating stock directly is one of the most tax-smart ways to give. By donating stock that has appreciated for more than a year, you are able to claim the full market value of the stock at the time of donation as a charitable deduction on your taxes, and avoid capital gains on the stock.
